ORDER

PENAL NOTICE

IF YOU THE WITHIN NAMED DEFENDANTS DISOBEY THIS ORDER YOU MAY BE HELD TO BE IN CONTEMPT OF COURT AND MAY BE IMPRISONED OR FINED OR YOU MAY BE FOUND TO BE GUILTY OF A CRIMINAL OFFENCE FOR WHICH YOU MAY BE IMPRISONED OR FINED OR BOTH.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

If you do not obey this Order you will be guilty of contempt of Court and you may be fined or sent to prison or may be guilty of a criminal offence for which you may be fined or sent to prison or both.

An application was made on 15 October 2006 by solicitors for the Claimants to the Court. The Court heard the application and accepted the undertakings in Schedule 1 at the end of this Order.

THE ORDER

UPON HEARING Counsel for the Claimants
AND UPON HEARING the First and Third Defendants
IT IS ORDERED THAT UNTIL TRIAL OR FURTHER ORDER

1. The First and Third Defendants, and all other persons acting as members, participants or supporters or in the name of the unincorporated association known as the SPEAK Campaign to prevent or obstruct the building of the Research Laboratory at the University be restrained from continuing to publish on the internet, by email or otherwise the name of or any information concerning the company asserted by SPEAK to be the contractor for the building of the research laboratory.
2. The First and Third Defendants do forthwith upon being notified of this order take all steps within their power to cause the name of or any information concerning the company asserted by SPEAK to be the contractor for the building of the research laboratory to be removed from the website

“www.speakcampaigns.org.uk” or any other website, including the Arkangel website.

3. The First and Third Defendants do forthwith (by 4p.m. on Friday, 20 October 2006) upon being notified of this order disclose orally to the Claimants’ solicitors the following information to the best of their respective knowledge, information and belief:
 - (a) the identity of all persons who manage publications on the SPEAK website
 - (b) the arrangements for the management and hosting of the SPEAK website, including full details of the persons able to publish or authorise publication on the SPEAK website, the identity of all webmasters or hosting company or internet service providers concerned, including details of any contracts for management of the website
 - (c) the identities of all persons who were concerned in causing the publication to be made on the SPEAK website on Monday 16 October 2006 of the identity of the company asserted by SPEAK to be the contractor for the building of the research laboratory

4. The First and Third Defendants do by 4p.m on Saturday, 21 October 2006 disclose to the Claimants’ solicitors:
 - (a) all documents in their possession custody or control relating to the information required to be provided under paragraph (3)
 - (b) an electronic copy of the email address list in full used for the publication in the SPEAK email Action Alert made on Monday 16 October 2006

and

state in writing what steps have been taken to comply with paragraph (2)

5. The identities of the persons or organisations provided to the Claimants under paragraphs (3) and (4) above be used by the Claimants only for the following purposes:
 - (a) in order to give notice to such persons or organisations of the prohibition in the injunction;
 - (b) in order, with the permission of the Court, to take legal steps to prevent a breach of this injunction.

6. Any notice which the Claimants intend to give pursuant to paragraph 5(a) above should be sent to the First and Third Defendants and any suggestions that they make as to the content of the notice should be carefully considered.
7. Liberty to apply.
8. Costs reserved.

Schedule 1 – Undertakings by Claimants

- (1) The Claimants undertake to compensate the Respondents to the Order for any loss which they suffer in the event that it is found that this Order should not have been granted and for which the Claimants are found liable to the Respondents.
- (2) To make and serve witness statements verifying the information given to the Court by the Claimants' solicitors in reliance upon which this order has been made.
